In the 5th century, in the place where today is Great Britain and Northern France, the Celts lived. They celebrated New Year with a festival called "Samhain on November 1st. It was a holiday of the end of the "Sun Season".



In the year 835 the Roman Catholic Church made November 1st a church holiday of all saints who don't have a special day in the year. This holiday was called "All Saints day" or "All Hallows Day".



People started to celebrate another holiday on October 31st - "All Hallows Eve" (the night before "All Hallows Day"). Now we call this festival "Halloween".

People strongly believed that Halloween is the night when communication between the worlds of living & the dead can
